**Texas A&M University presents "Architecture for Health" Visiting Lecture Series  
with David Kamp, FASLA, LF as Speaker**

New York, NY – January 26, 2010 – Texas A&M University College of Architecture presents this Spring semester's "Architecture for Health" Visiting Lecture Series with David Kamp, FASLA, LF and Principal of Dirtworks, PC as speaker. David will speak on “Nature and Human Nature” at the Wright Gallery of the Langford Building within the university campus on January 27, 2010.

The presentation will begin with the idea of relating nature to human nature in design. It will also explore specific site design issues unique to “special needs” populations. Several internationally recognized projects will be presented, notably the Elizabeth and Nona Evans Restorative Garden and the Keene State College Natural Sciences Courtyard.

The Spring semester's "Architecture for Health" Visiting Lecture Series at the College of Architecture at Texas A&M University is part of the multidisciplinary health design program at Texas A&M. This weekly health lecture series, held every Wednesday until April is well attended by students and faculty. David Kamp, FASLA, LF, has over 30 years’ experience in public and private sectors.
